

BY-LAW NO. 10-2002

**BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHCLAIR FOR
CLOSING A HIGHWAY PURSUANT TO SECTION 209 OF THE MUNICIPAL ACT.**

Whereas Section 209 of the Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

- (1) Subject to Subsections (2) and (3), the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws (c) for closing any highway;

And Whereas the bridge, being part of the road allowance of the following described highway was completely burned in a fire and is no longer useable by motor vehicles.

And Whereas the Council of the Rural Municipality of Strathclair deems it wise and expedient and in the public's best interest to close the aforementioned bridge.

Now Therefore the Council of the Rural Municipality of Strathclair, in Council duly assembled, does hereby enact as follows:

- 1) That all that portion of the public highway described as follows:

The bridge over the Little Saskatchewan River being part of Road Plan 3259, lying within Keeseekoowenin First Nation lands in NE 9-18-21 WPM.

Be and the same is hereby closed.

- 2) That this by-law shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister.
