

**THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF STRATHCLAIR  
BY-LAW NO. 6-2002**

Being a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Strathclair to amend the Rural Municipality of Strathclair Zoning By-Law No. 15/86 as amended by By-Law No. 4-2000.

Whereas Section 47(2) of the Planning Act provides that a Zoning By-law may be amended and the Rural Municipality of Strathclair Zoning By-Law was amended by By-Law #4-2000;

Now Therefore the Council of the Rural Municipality of Strathclair in meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That Part IV, Section 6(9) be amended by amending clause (iii) as follows:
  - (iii) A conditional use approval is required for each livestock production operation located in the A80 zone that does or is proposed to produce 400 or more animal units. In reviewing an application, Council will consider operation confinements areas, and waste disposal sites and methods, including manure spreading.
  
2. That Part IV, Section 6(10)(a) be amended as follows:
  - (a) New or expanding livestock production operation confinement area and concentrated waste disposal site must have a minimum setback distance of 328 feet from any surface waterbody, groundwater, or domestic water supply.
  - (b) Council may vary the minimum setback requirement upon application for a variation order. In reviewing an application and making any order, Council may consider, among other things, recommendations from the Province and measures to be taken to prevent water pollution and land erosion.
  
3. That Part IV, Section 6(11) is amended by substituting therewith the new Section 6(11) as follows:  
ANIMAL UNITS (A.U.)  
6.(11) The following Table of Animal units – (A.U.) is to be used in determining the number of A.U. produced by a livestock production operation.
